THE APPLICATION PROCESS:

We are looking for queer new writing brought by lgbtq+ artists. Our aim will be to create a varied and diverse programme across the festival, both in form and content. We will be assessing submissions creatively, and we aim to give slots to shows we think could benefit most from being part of the festival.

We are aware that some individuals may not have a team with whom to apply. Part of our aim is to connect, for example, costume designers and directors, or musicians and writers, who may not otherwise have had the network required to mount a show. We will do our best to put you in touch with others interested in taking part.

Production companies apply with a show. The show can be any level of 'produced', but we ask you to specify if you are applying for a 'scratch slot' or a 'full slot'

Scratch Slots: Scratch night style content. This may be individual monologues, scenes, or rehearsed readings of short plays. Max length 20 minutes.

Full Slots: One-act plays that suit a 50-seater black box space. 50-80 minutes.

WHAT WE OFFER YOU

Scratch Slots:

- A performance slot of up to 20 minutes within a scratch night
- A half hour tech slot
- Assistance with marketing of the scratch night as a whole
- An opportunity for feedback and conversation with other artists at a similar stage in their careers
- Creative support running up to the festival
- A contribution towards expenses

Full Slots:

- A performance slot of 50-80 minutes
- A 2 1/2 hour tech slot
- Assistance with marketing of the production
- A contribution towards production costs (approximately £500, depending on scale and need).

WHAT WE NEED FROM YOU

Scratch Slots

- A script, anywhere from a few pages to a finished product.
- A completed application form

Full Slots

- A script, anywhere from first draft to a finished product.
- A completed application form
- A lighting operator (we can offer an introduction to the BT lighting set up, so any member of the team can do this, even without experience!)

We're excited to hear your stories!

Queer Fest is an opportunity to connect and experiment. We want the festival to reflect the diversity of the queer community. If you're not sure if your piece is ready, just send it, we'd love to read it!
